### **PROJECT NAME:**

The "**BALIK ESKWELA 2008-09**" is the contingency plan preparation for this incoming opening of classes which shall commence on June 10, 2008. And its formulate a FIRE SAFETY PREPAREDNESS program of **BFP ARMM** towards the conduct of inspection and to give information drive among pupils and students in different school level. And it also requires all school buildings, dormitories and other types of educational occupancy to abide the implementation of the Rules and Regulations under PD 1185 (FIRE CODE OF THE PHILIPPINES).

### **RATIONALE:**

Based on the observation for the p so to f years fire incident report in different educational institution in ARMM its shown rarely happened that involves damage of properties and casualties during opening of the classes ,These signify that effective fire safety/prevention measures were implemented to different school of learning in the region.

And to anticipate any untoward incident that may be happen during the opening of classes- Therefore, it is required to all fire safety inspector assigned in their respective ACT and other convened to conduct massive inspection and information drive to school building, dormitories and other educational types of occupancy to secure safety among pupils and students in different school level

### **SITUATIONER:**

The BFP ARMM as concerned agency under DILG, is responsible of PUBLIC SAFETY through prevention and suppression of destructive fires, and investigation of all kinds of destructive fires.

  - 6.5 Dormitories within university campus and near primeses

## **ACTUAL Operational (IN CASE OF FIRE CALL AND OTHER EMERGENCY)**

- 7.1 Proper deployment of Firefighting units Volunteer Fire Brigades, EMS, Patrol 117, and Other Law Enforcement agencies including Regional Disaster Coordinating Council.
- 7.2 All Firefighters including their respective units must always vigilant and serviceable to respond any untoward fire alarm.
- 7.3 Conduct rescue and medical services to affected victims especially children in pre-school and elementary level.
- 7.4 Lateral Coordination to all concerned agencies/units for immediate Response.

# CONTINGENCY PLAN :COTABATO CITY -ARMM

## PROJECT NAME:

1. The OPERATIONAL CONTINGENCY PLAN is formulated to intensify its fire safety awareness and identify what specific location in the community known as most highly vulnerable to fire occurrence under the area of responsibility of BFP-ARMM.

On these contingency plan, it also implement what course of action and make recommendation/remedies to ensure the public of a fire safety conscious society,

## AUTHORITY:

2. As per memorandum order dtd 23 July 2008, duly signed by DIRECTOR ENRIQUE C LINSANGAN, FIRE CHIEF

## RATIONALE:

- 3.1 For the past few years, the success of any fire protection and prevention endeavor relies on how effective the preparedness program implemented on respective area of responsibility. It is an event that continuous implementation of PD 1185 especially fire safety inspection and other preventive measures in the community may help eliminate or minimize chances of fire occurrence.
- 3.2 The concept to decline fire incident cases may contribute through implementation of operation contingency plan which compliance of fire safety as result indicates the degree of hazard found in every type of occupancies.

## SITUATIONER:

- 4.1 The Regional Operation Division of BFP-ARMM is responsible to formulate a PRE-PLANNING, RESCUE and EVACUATION in case of fire conflagration arises on the affected area
- 4.2 PFM/CFM/MFM operating units must formulate a separate CONTINGENCY PLANS and indicates areas prone to fire incidence or consider as vulnerable to fire occurrence.

## PROBLEMS AND THREATS:

- 5.1 Illegal settlers and shanties constructed combustible light materials.
- 5.2 Dilapidated government building structures erected inside school campus including residential houses made of light materials
- 5.3 Lack of fire hydrants installed in the community and also poor communication in case of response to fire call.
- 5.4 Bomb threats made by lawless group
- 5.5 Municipalities located in a remote area were response of fire truck cause delay due to poor road maintenance.

## PLANNING OPERATION:

- 6.1 To conduct actual Fire drill exercises, fire safety preparedness, full implementation of fire safety inspection under PD 1185.
- 6.2 To monitor all vulnerable fire prone areas and encourage all operating units to disseminate information regarding fire safety education.
- 6.3 To inculcate the mind of general public the adverse effects of destructive fire that cause displacement, loss of properties, loss of job, unrealized dreams, economics sabotage and most unfortunately loss of lives.

## ACTUAL OPERATION: (IMPLAN in case of fire call)

- 7.1 Proper deployment of fire fighting units, Volunteers Fire Brigade, EMS, Patrol 117.
- 7.2 To coordinate to other law enforcement agencies particularly Philippine National Police and Armed Forces of the Philippines to cordon affected area while fire fighting is on progress.
- 7.3 To coordinate with Regional Disaster Coordinating Council, DSWD and Non Governmental Organization incase of fire conflagration to assist fire victims.
- 7.4 To coordinate all standby fire fighting units for a quick response.
- 7.5 Conduct rescue and medical services if needs arises.
