Respectfully submitted to the Office of the C, BFP Bureau of Fire Protection, National HQ 145 Union Square Condominium, 156th Avenue, Cubao, Quezon City, Attn : DF Operation is the OPERATIONAL CONTINGENCY PLAN of Highly Vulnerable Areas, this Region.

A. GENERAL

The increasing growth of population in a certain locality consequently increase in the numbers of houses and shelters, thus the advent of a dense population arises. As a result of this projected growth the possibility of the occurrence and the increase in the number of energized equipment and the other careless individual all contributes to the occurrence of a conflagration. As a matter of concern this station must work collectively if only to minimize of not possibly pre-empt the occurrence of so called destructive fires.

B i ASSUMPTION:

The establishment of a fire station and the existence of its Fire Fighting Apparatus and personnel contributed to the economic stability of a particular locale. Business and entrepreneur within the outside the particular area is less likely frightened to invest for reasons that the presence of Fire Engine Company may lessen the chances of fire incidence.

C. MISSION:

To establish procedure, define responsibilities and establish well coorditl _d effort in the conduct of Fire fighting operation, Fire loss prevention and property conservation.

D. EXECUTION:

Implementation of the plans will be in accordance with 3 phases of emergency management, stated hereunder;

A) Pre-emergency phase

1. Fire prevention activities such as education dissemination, Inspection, Code enforcement and the Fire investigation.
2. Collect pertinent information through ocular inspection, company inspection, survey drafting of sunburn map to provide detailed knowledge of the potential fire problem in our area of responsibility.
3. Analyze information gathered to determined the vital and pertinent fir: suppression operation and formulate workable and operational plans and same should be disseminated to

- a. The BFP Malilipot Fire Station and the Provincial ground SOP on running assignment of the fire truck and dispatching of subordinates unit during conflagration.
- b. Assistance of other Local Government Units (LGU)/ Non-Governmental Organization (NGO) will also be sought to complement Fire Ground Requirement on the operation.

1. Philippines National police who has the operational jurisdiction over the area gutted by Fire must respond to said place to provide security support by cordoning the scene of the fire to avoid looting/criminal activities and provide traffic directions.

2. NGO's Radio Handler Group

a. To provide first hand information of any fire discovered within their respective area and follow-up data as to circumstance to the progress of said fire or other helpful information as basis for the fire ground commander in his decision.

b. Assist the responding personnel by providing vital information (Fire ground factor) which is so precious in the fire ground maneuvers and fire fighting tactics/techniques.

c. Set a reconnaissance/look out and a coordinator between operation personnel and fire truck in any given sector as previously assigned by fire ground commander.

3. Albay Electric Cooperative (ALECO) - to respond to all fire emergencies within AOR to disconnect live wires, which could be hazard to the responding fire fighting and individuals within the fire scene.

4. REHABILITATION PHASE

The following government will undertake rehabilitation phase agencies if the conflagration occurred at the highly density residential zones to wit:

1. Municipal Health Office

a. Provide direct services and for technical assistance during conflagration

b. Undertake necessary measure to prevent disease and other health hazard which may affect fire victims,

c. Organized reaction teams in the municipality to provide medical assistance to fire Victims.

d. Provide transportation facilities to fire victims with the used of ambulance.

2. DILG

a. Direct the local government units to organize and train/support Disaster Groups/'Reaction Teams.

b. Oversee the organization of Disaster coordinating council in the Municipality/Barangay.

3. MEO (Municipal Engineering Office)

a. Provide heavy and light equipment during fire fighting operation and for rescue and recovery operation.

b. Assist and provide information facilities, transport relief/supply

MANAGEMENT SYSTEM:

5. Communication section of this office together with the provincial office and that with the municipality will provide the following services.

- a) Receiving notification of emergencies from the public
- b) Alerting and dispatching personnel/equipment
- c) Coordinating the activities of units engaged in emergencies/incidents.
- d) Providing non emergency communication or coordination of Fire fighting units.
- e) Dispatching of Fire trucks from other municipalities/cities will be from the provincial office alone.

6. COORDINATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. This pre-Fire plan/contingency plan will serve as declaration of support among various government agencies involved during Fire emergencies.
2. Maximum coordination is emphasized among task agencies in all phases of operation.
3. All task agencies/unit should develop and execute their implementing plan relative thereto and same should be disseminated to the other involved agency

7. LOGISTIC

All agencies will provide their own logistical financial support to their respective Contingent.

8. CONTROL

The most ranking officer in the Fire scene will, from our SOP will execute the direction and control in the Fire ground. Control of all other level units will be exercised thru their respective immediate superior.

The overall disaster activities are under the supervision and control Municipal mayor as chain – of command of the municipal disaster coordinating council,

II. SITUATION:

Its not only during summer season that the Bureau of Fire Protection anticipates an increase on fire incidence, but also throughout the year due to accidents and carelessness.

As a preventive measure, the Bureau Protection of Camalig will launch an information campaign on fire protection; a campaign that would reach the smallest unit of community, the family. The BFP is an agency true to its vision and mission, it shall exhaust all possible means to deliver the message: the need for firesafety and prevention to everyone.

III. MISSION

1. The Camalig BFP shall exhaust its capabilities in ensuring the safety of the populace in case of destructive fire and to rescue/assist persons injured during fire incidence.
2. In order to compensate for the deficiency of the Bureau of Fire Protection in terms of firefighting equipments gadgets and apparatus, it seek to intensify the fire prevention aspect.

IV. EXECUTION:

1 Concept of Operations

This operation shall involve the utilization of all available personnel in the station who shall ensure the safety of the populace. The Camalig BFP will coordinate with the local officials to inform them about our activities that if they could provide assistance particularly in evacuating victims to safer place.

2. Tasks

1. MFM-Provide overall control and supervision in the execution of this plan.
2. Operation NCO-Disseminate information coming from MFM/Local Official with close coordination with local PNP
3. Firesafety Inspectors-responsible for the conduct of fire safety inspection. Their task is to undertake firesafety for the populace.

1. All personnel shall be aware of this plan.

3. Offduty personnel must report to the station.

VIII. EFFECTIVITY:

The peace and order situation of the City could be considered to be generally peaceful but treacherous. The occurrence of criminality is within manageable level. With regards to fire occurrence, it is seldom, but the barangays from the coastal is more hazardous and treacherous to constituent because of the distance which is 58 km. from the Poblac^o and the condition of the road. So far the BFP personnel with the assisted of the Fire Volunteer Bride and the I_ it remains to control the situation of the area. The area has two season, the dry and wet season that occasionally has brought light or tremendous effect to living condition of the populace. The educational profile of the City could be considered as fair compare to other towns and City in the province. It has a total of 50 private and public, elementary and secondary school. It has I district hospital and 14 private hospitals/clinics to gather the needs of the people and other adjoining towns within the 3^r district of the province.

III- Assumption

At any opportune time, threat to this city is the communist terrorist group coming from other provinces, which will conduct operation against the government and its vital installation, by means of high powered gun, incendiary bomb, or maybe chemical gas, which may cause a big fire conflagration, which is disastrous to human lives and properties of public just to show sentiment and grievances to the government.

The whole to safeguard the lives and properties for the constituents of the city Ligao from any actual or eminent danger or hazard by all forms kinds of natural calamities, man made disturbances and destruct thereby population.

- b) Approval of application for leave will be recalled as the need arises to maintain the full strength.
- c) Proper and accurate disposition of troops to maximize the function of each personnel that will commensurate their field of expertise.

FIRE PREVENTION SECTION:

- a) Full implementation of PD 1185 thru enormous conduct of fire safety inspection in all business and commercial establishments within the AOR.
- b) Activate/organize fire volunteers and enhance their knowledge and skills to assist the local BFP unit in times of fire emergencies.

OPERATION SECTION:

- a) Maintain the good condition of the Fire Equipments and conduct regular warm up of fire engines
- b) Incase of fire alarm, fire engine (2) will immediately respond as first run to size up and control the situation while fire engine I will remain standby and serve as second run whenever necessary.
- c) Nearest augmentation unit will be alarmed at once as additional support unit.
- d) All off-duty personnel are directed to monitor thru their personal cell phones and to report immediately in case of fire occurrence to assist the on-duty personnel.
- e) To act without undue delay on fire calls and utilize all available firefighting equipment and resources.

INTEL AND INVESTIGATION SECTION:

- a) Coordinate with the local PNP/Intel units and other concerned agencies for the resolution of the case.
- b) Closely monitor and gather accurate information to identify cause and origin of fire and to file appropriate legal action if necessary.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES SECTION:

- a) Monitor health condition of the personnel
- b) Conduct regular physical fitness exercise for a good body condition and better firefighting performance
- c) Report any serious health problem and recommend to undergo medical treatment.

Fire Contingency/Defense Plan

I - OBJECTIVE;

The fire contingency /Defense plan was prepared and recommended for implementation by the Bureau of Fire Protection Capalonga Fire Station for which its main purpose is to achieved as effective efficient and well coordinated plan of action between the different concerned agencies to avoid the occurrence of fire within our area of responsibilities and in case of fire may occur, a well executed plan of action could be attained.

II - CONCERNED AGENCIES:

1. Municipal Government of Capalonga
2. Bureau of Fire Protection - Capalonga Fire Station and neighboring Fire Station
3. The Philippine National Police
4. Concerned Barangay unit

III -ACTION PLAN'

Fire and other forms of natural and man-made calamities are one of the foremost concerns of our government today. It is because with these phenomena, many properties are destroyed and many lives are lost. This however, can be prevented when people are not caught unprepared during the onset of these calamities.

It is on these context that the Capalonga Fire Staion in coordination with the local government unit , DILG and the Philippine National Police designed the creation of a civic-oriented group (Disaster/Fire Brigade) who will be tasked in assisting regular fire fighters in suppressing all destructive fires and augments the workforce in responding to other natural calamities that brought wrath to citizenry.

Considering the distance of Capalonga to other municipalities when can augment assistance during emergency cases and on the assumption that outside help may not be available immediately, it is but practical that civilian volunteers must be organized and trained in every community and or establishment.

The creation of disaster /fire brigade is also mandated by the mission and vision of the DILG and objectives under the implementation of RA 7160 which states that the Local Governments Units "Chief Executive power, duties and functions with the efficient fire purpose of organizing emergency group for the effective management and efficient fire prevention and control and respond to the natural calamities that yearly brought wrath destruction and even death to citizenry.

Based on the assessment filed on this station mostly fire occurred in Barangay Poblacion of this municipality, because of this situation there is a need for all the concerned barangay to have a well coordinated plan of action, as follow: The organized Volunteer fire brigade should establish at least a six (6) man fire brigade team equip with portable fire extinguisher and drums filled with water. This team will take the initial action in case a fire may occur, promote fire prevention, effort within the area and to relay immediately to the fire station for immediate fire response. The brigade team shall continuously suppress fire by means of bucket relay until the arrival of BFP firefighting team.

BFP duty personnel upon receiving the message coming from the informer shall immediately respond to the fire call and make an extra effort to extinguish the fire . The fire ground commander shall assess the situation and inform the Office of Provincial Fire Marshal for any assistant may be given to the situation. The Philippine National Police shall cordon the area to avoid traffic and looters.

It is essential that this planning include members of the community beyond the fire service . well targeted, organized, effective, measurable program supported by the fire station and involving the community are the most successful at saving lives, preventing injuries and reducing property damage.

OPERATIONAL CONTINGENCY PLAN (Area: Brgy. Parang, Jose Panganiban, Camarines Norte)

I - BACKGROUND

Barangay Parang, Jose Panganiban, Camarines Norte, is a barangay almost within the town proper. It is highly populated and houses are mostly made up of light materials constructed almost without boundaries. Access and pathways is for human, motorcycles and bicycles only that no type of 4 wheel vehicles will have its way through. This barangay is composed a (6) six puroks with a total of Three Hundred Thirteen (313) houses and a population of Seven Thousand Five Hundred Ninety Five (7,595) inhabitants. The only service road for this barangay is the Gov Padilla Sr. Blvd which can provide services such as, for transportation, pedestrian lanes and services for emergency vehicles such as ambulance, police and fire trucks.

II - OPERATION PLAN:

In our desire to response effectively in fire emergency to this barangay the following is our course of action, to wit:

1. Manpower as stakeholders in case of fire and other emergencies.
2. Concern of Barangay officials.
3. Preparedness and vigilant of the residents.
4. Information dissemination.
5. Local executive and Sangguniang Bayan.
6. Concerned Authorities (PNP/DSDW/JPWD Etc)
7. Engine Supports (Responding Fire Stns.)

III. IMPLAN

1. Barangay Tanod Purok officials were deputized as Vol fire Brigade. They will be our support group in case of fire incident.
2. Coordinated with the barangay officials for round the clock guarding by their barangay tanods particularly at nighttime for monitoring and immediate reporting in case of fire occurrence.
3. Information campaign for the residents to maximized fire prevention. Observant of fire safety and preparedness in case of fire emergency.
4. Tapped the services of the local radio station for information dissemination regarding fire prevention.
5. Informed the local government unit regarding the situation and hazard of said barangay in case of fire and how to control the continuous squatting in the area.
6. Requested the JPWD through the LGU and Sangguniang Barangay to construct additional fire hydrants and how to divert water pressure in case of fire. Coordinated with the PNP, DSWD & other concerned agencies of their tasks in case of fire emergency.
7. In case of conflagration, aside from the service engine of this station the Jpang Local Fire Station is our immediate back up. If the necessity requires we will ask the support of Paracale FS and the Labo FS.

PUBLIC RELATION IN AN EMERGENCY SITUATION

It is important that the facts of any emergency be handled intelligently with the press public, fire personnel. In a serious emergency, a highly confused situation can exist. All kind o rumors and exaggerated stories/statements may arise. Mishandling the news of an emergency cat harm community.

It is important to say the right things in an emergency. Also, refusal to co-operate with thl press can only cause difficulties and misrepresentation of the real facts. Public Informatioi Officer will take over the responsibility for gathering, clearing and transmitting statements tc news media. Any inquiries received at the station should referred to City Fire Marshal. When the incident is so serious that the member of the press is expected to arrive at the scene, the Cit' Fire Marshal / Public Information Officer and Fire Arson Investigator should be the one tc released statement regarding the incident.

1. Use short sentences to provide a brief and clear description of what has happened.
2. Confine to facts, do not give the cause but say that an investigation will be conducted to ascertain the cause.
3. Include details such as time, place (only if the facts have been definitely established)
4. Make clear whether the incident is over or still going on. If it is continuing, tell what steps are being taken to control it.

OPERATIONAL CONTINGENCY PLAN PD HIGHLY VULNIRABLE TO FIRE OCCURENCES PD

1. SITUATION;

Among the 36 barangay of the Municipality of Cataingan, the BFP Fire Station has identified barangay Poblacion vulnerable to fire hazards considering that it is a commercial district manipulated by number of people migrated, the increasing demographic habitat, the on-going construction of commercial buildings, establishments and houses and the land use of the barangay which contributed to the use of bus terminal and vendors has resulted to the traffic congestion of vehicles and passers by.

The unavailability of water source and the presence of urban squatters and shanties are hazard factors poised to be classified the area of barangay Poblacion as "Fire Prone Areas"

a. FRIENDLY FORCES:

1. Barangay fire volunteer brigade;
2. Local PNP and Tanods;
3. Red cross, RHU and NGO's;
4. Local officials;
5. Coast Guard;
6. CIDG and;
7. Concerned individual.

b. Fire fighting Capability:

The BFP Cataingan Fire Station has equipped with one (1) unit Fire truck and is manned by the undersigned Municipal Fire Marshal (CFM) with nine (9) personnel assigned. With this number, 3 of them were assigned in the office for administrative function, while the remaining 6 personnel was placed in the fire operation section.

Personnel has maintained the twenty four (24) hour duty to response for any emergency call. The depleted number of personnel has augmented by the forces of barangay based volunteer brigade and tanods to sustain combat on firefighting operation in their AOR and the security assistance of the local PNP's.

c. Communication Capability:

Although Cataingan Fire Station has no telephone line communication and operation response solely depends on foot patrol communication, however due to the advance communication technology all personnel has now its own cell phone which can be utilized and contacted for any emergency call and response.

II. MISSION;

1. Be able to have a truly, effective functional contingency plan to prevent fire occurrences, rescue operation to save lives and properties along with the identified fire prone barangay of poblacion, Cataingan, Masbate.
2. To control fire at soonest possible time so as not to extend fire damages to other neighboring barangays by consolidating all friendly forces of the government.

III. EXECUTION;

1. Concept of Operation;

A. Pre-Fire Planning Period:

1. Re-organized and train barangay base fire volunteer brigade and conduct drill test exercises quarterly.
2. Conduct seminars along with the program of BFP on Fire Education, Advocacy and Preparedness.
3. Intensify inspection of buildings and houses and uncompromisingly enforce the Fire Code of the Phil. (P.D. 1185).
4. Establishment of fund support for equipping, training and drill of barangay tanods utilizing as Fire Volunteers.
5. Pass an ordinance prohibiting or regulating of burning fire and rubbish fires.
6. An ordinance on imposition of fire zoning.
7. Revitalized the patrol system within the AOR with the support and cooperation of the LGU.

8. Establish a barangay alarm system which will be used for any calamity or disaster early warning device.

B. During Fire Disaster;

B. 1-a. Tasking;

A1. The BFP Cataingan Fire Station shall take for fire response without delay upon informed or called as transmitted through sign or messages

- * He shall maintain fire truck and fire personnel readily available within 24 hours on emergency responses.
- * He shall act as an overall chairman of fire suppression committee to secure, salvage property deploy the elements of responding team.

B2. Barangay officials shall immediately inform the Fire Station on exact location and extent of fire.

- He shall supervise, guide and monitor on the movement of fire volunteers including the utilization of affected persons of fire to the nearest evacuation center.
- He shall also manage the affected community for immediate transportation of fire victims using any available vehicles to district hospital or nearest barangay health station.
- Assist the responding fire trucks and PNP in the area.

C3. The local PNP shall immediately response without delay to the fire scene for crowd control, traffic flow and conduct security measures.

- He shall assist the responding fire truck to immediately take the best passion for fire fighting, rescue and evacuation operation.
- He shall implement tight security, control and cordoning the fire scene to avoid looters.

D4. Barangay Fire volunteers shall assist the BFP fire truck in the fire fighting and other similar rescue operation as may be directed by the Fire ground commander.

ccThe LGU T shall extend necessary assistance not listed nor J identified in this plan for the interest for public safety and velfare of the people.

F6. Barangay tanods shall conduct evacuation of salvage properties to **the** nearest identified **safest** **evacuation center**.

- **He** shall assist the **local PNP** in terms of security and *cordoning* the fire scene *so as to* protect the evidences and other important properties,

G7. RHU/DISTRICT HOSPITAL- shall immediately cause to use the ambulance for rescue and transfer of the fire victims.

2. SAMMARY OF THE EXECUTION OF FIRE OPERATION;

1. Feedback signal on fire alarm
2. Identify the caller, exact location of fire and magnitude of incident.
3. Information, positive, alert all friendly forces especially the local PNP.
4. Fire truck response to the fire scene.
5. Local PNP shall assist the responding fire truck and cordon the area.
6. BFP fire fighters with barangay volunteers shall take fire suppression.
7. Fire ground commander shall manage the fire scene, disposition and maneuver of personnel.
8. Coordination must be maintained.

IV. INSTRUCTION/COORDINATION;

1. All elements identified as friendly forces shall take standby ready to be deployed at any cause of instruction.
2. The MFM together with the office of the Mayor shall take necessary coordination along all units in the area.
3. They shall supervise all elements of the disaster teams in the discharging of their defined function and responsibilities.
4. Lateral coordination and communication among all agencies and concerned organization must be maintain

V. ADMINITRATION AND LOGISTIC,

1. BFP Cataingan Fire Station shall hold over the administration and disposition of all fire fighting equipment and fire prevention.
2. Fire truck deployment shall be operationally supervised and maintain by the BFP Cataingan FS including of fire personnel.
3. He shall cause assistance from the LGU to augment logistical needs of firefighting apparatus, maintenance and morale of personnel.

VI. COMMAND AND SIGNAL:

A. Signal;

In the absence of telephone line communication of BFP Cataingan Fire Station, the following implied signals to response are as follows;

1. Continuous ringing of cathedral bell
2. Rapid gunshots
3. Cell phone call, and
4. Foot patrol information

B. Command;

BFP Cataingan Fire Station shall take for command and control of the contingency plan.
